OVERVIEW

Martin Road Elementary School has approximately 420 students who are in our Hybrid program. 50% of those students are in school on Mondays and Tuesdays with the remaining 50% in school on Thursdays and Fridays. Every student in the school has a full day of virtual learning on Wednesdays.

Martin Road will provide daily student engagement on the two days each week that students are not physically in the building. This will be done through:

Teacher Office Hours

- On Mondays and Tuesdays from 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM, every homeroom teacher is available via email and Microsoft Teams for students and families who are in school on Thursdays and Fridays.
- On Thursdays and Fridays from 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM, every homeroom teacher is available via email and Microsoft Teams for students and families who are in school on Mondays and Tuesdays.

Reading Specialist Classes

- On Mondays, our Reading Specialist will have classes with the 2nd and 3rd grade students who are physical in school on Thursdays and Fridays. Each class will have approximately 15 students and will last for 40 minutes.
- On Tuesdays, our Reading Specialist will have classes with the 4th and 5th grade students who are physical in school on Thursdays and Fridays. Each class will have approximately 15 students and will last for 40 minutes.
- On Thursdays, our Reading Specialist will have classes with the 2nd and 3rd grade students who are physical in school on Mondays and Tuesdays. Each class will have approximately 15 students and will last for 40 minutes.
- On Fridays, our Reading Specialist will have classes with the 2nd and 3rd grade students who are physical in school on Mondays and Tuesdays. Each class will have approximately 15 students and will last for 40 minutes.

Teacher provided work

 For the two days that the students are not physically in school or fully virtual (Wednesdays), every homeroom teacher will provide a list of work/tasks/projects that need to be completed with the amount of time that each task would take. In addition, students will be assigned Reading A-Z work, Raz-Kids work and I-Ready work.
